



CODE OF CONDUCT –
TEAM MANAGER

Updated: February 2025

All Alkimos Raiders Team Managers are required to carefully read and adhere to this 'Code of Conduct':

- Remember that you are representing the Alkimos Raiders when you are undertaking your role, and your behaviour is a reflection of the Alkimos Raiders and Wanneroo Basketball Association.
- Never ridicule or yell at a player for making a mistake or not winning a game.
- Be reasonable on your players' time, energy and enthusiasm.
- Operate within the rules and spirit of our sport and teach your players that rules and Codes of Conduct are mutual agreements which no one involved should break.
- Lead by example in matters of team control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sport. This includes opponents, coaches, officials, parents and spectators. In addition, encourage all players to do the same.
- Show concern and caution towards sick/injured players. Follow the advice of a physician when determining whether players are ready to resume.
- Constantly communicate with coaches and players and their parents as to what the team is trying to achieve.
- Never undermine the coach or get involved in coaching from the sideline.
- Do not dispute the decisions of officials.
- As a Team Manager, you must set the example by being a good role model and reinforce the Player Code of Conduct. In the event you receive a technical foul or are reported/ejected from a game, you may be called before the WBA to explain your actions.

AGREEMENT...

'As a condition of entry to participate in Alkimos Raiders and Wanneroo Basketball Association Inc. events, programs or competitions, I agree to abide by the Managers Code of Behaviour as outlined above.

I understand that breaches of the above conditions may be referred either directly to the Alkimos Raiders, to an appointed Management Committee or to a full tribunal, who at their discretion, can impose penalties up to and including the immediate removal of a manager from Alkimos Raiders and Wanneroo Basketball Association events, programs or competitions entirely.

For more serious breaches, the Games Manager on duty has the authority to immediately request the removal of a manager from the Wanneroo Basketball Association venue and refer the matter to the Tribunal for further action.

Additionally, I understand that the team that I am associated with will be help responsible for my conduct and may be excluded from participating in Alkimos Raiders and Wanneroo Basketball Association events, programs or competitions entirely.
